

## Minor League Review

July 2 – July 8

### Ottawa Lynx

Went 2-6 for the week and remained in 6<sup>th</sup> place (35-52) in the International League's Northern Division, 14 games behind . . . CF Chris Roberson hit safely in every game and batted .342 with 13 hits and 8 runs . . . C Jason Jaramillo also hit safely in all eight games and batted .321 with nine hits and a home run . . . DH Gary Burnham, 4-for-4, with a season high 5 RBI at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (7/6) . . . All-Star note: C Jason Jaramillo was named to the Triple-A All-Star Game giving the Phillies an All-Star catcher at every minor league level in 2007 (Jason Hill-Reading, Lou Marson-Clearwater and Tuffy Gosewisch-Lakewood).

### Reading Phillies

4-3 week kept Reading T-4<sup>th</sup> place (44-45) in the Eastern League's Southern Division, 9 games out of first place . . . Scored 21 runs vs New Britain on 7/2, which was the most runs scored by the R-Phils since 5/27/91 (22-2, GM 2 vs New Britain). Every starter had at least two hits, one RBI, and one run scored . . . C Jason Hill has a team-high 19-game hitting streak and is batting .338 (24-71, 18 RBI) in that span . . . 3B Mike Costanzo hit two home runs in the week to bring his Eastern League-leading total to 17 HR.

### Clearwater Threshers

A rain shortened week left the Threshers 2-2 and in 3<sup>rd</sup> place (9-6, 48-37 overall) in the Florida State League's Western Division, 2 games behind . . . OF Greg Golson matched his career-best hitting streak of 12 games and hit .370 with 9 RBI during that time . . . LHP Josh Outman improved to 9-3 and lowered his ERA to 2.58 in six no-hit innings vs Ft. Myers on July 7 . . . DL Note: RHP Tom Gordon made two rehab starts (one which was later postponed) and threw 2.2 scoreless innings. He allowed one hit and one walk while also striking out a batter.

### Lakewood BlueClaws

Went 4-3, good for 1st place (11-6, 44-38 overall) in the South Atlantic League's Northern Division . . . CF Quintin Berry reached base safely in every game and hit safely in all but one. He batted .346 with six runs and stole his 33<sup>rd</sup> base of the season, good for 3<sup>rd</sup> in the SAL . . . Every BlueClaws starter had at least one hit in their 7/5 win vs Lake County (12-4) . . . Futures Game Note: 2B Adrian Cardenas was 1-for-1 with a single in the Futures Game in San Francisco, part of MLB's All-Star Weekend. RHP Carlos Carrasco of the R-Phils pitched one scoreless inning.

### Williamsport Crosscutters

4-3 week, T-2<sup>nd</sup> place (12-8) in the New York-Penn League's Pinckney Division, 1 game behind . . . 2B Tyler Mach hit .414 with 12 hits, including four multi-hit games. Collected a career-best 5 RBI at Jamestown on 7/2 and 8 RBI in a two-day span . . . RHP Drew Naylor defeated State College on Thursday (7/5), 7.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R, 1 ER, HB, 11 SO. Dating to last season, Naylor is 5-0 with a 1.95 ERA in six career starts. It also marked the first time in his career that he struck out 10 or more batters in a game. Naylor is 4-0 this season with a 0.62 ERA.

### Gulf Coast Phillies

Lost four straight to end the week at 2-4, T-4<sup>th</sup> place (8-8) in the Gulf Coast's Northern Division, 1.5 games behind . . . 1B/OF Francisco Murillo had his 10-game hitting streak snapped on 7/6, which dated back to 6/22. He batted .378 (14-37), with 4 HR and 14 RBI.
